TASK DESCRIPTION

Scientific work is planned as part of the NCN OPUS project "Biodegradable, biocompatible and interactive surfactants - as an ecologically safe alternative to synthetic compounds in the generation of foams and emulsions for cosmetic, medical and industrial applications". The doctoral student's tasks will include the work planned in the project, in particular, development of emulsions based on aqueous or oil-soluble biosurfactants, investigation of adsorption processes, emulsification, emulsion stability as reported by the effect of other chemical additives on the observed processes and stability of the obtained material. Additionally, the doctoral student's tasks will include analyzing the obtained research results and disseminating them in the form of scientific articles and conference presentations.
