Jerzy Haber Institute of Catalysis and Surface Chemistry PAS invites applications for an Adiunct (post-doc) in the Theoretical and Experimental Biocatalysis group. The candidates who meet the conditions stated in the act "Ustawa o Polskiej Akademii Nauk" dated 30 April 2010 (Dz.U. 2018 poz. 1475 z póź. zm.), art 89. Ust. 4 for the position of Research Assistant are encouraged to apply for the position.

The candidate will participate in research within the OPUS 28 research project "Design of enzymes catalysing interfacial solid/liquid reaction" no 2024/55/B/ST4/02371, conducted in the Theoretical and Experimental Biocatalysis group in close collaboration with the group of Prof. Artur Góra from the Silesian University of Technology, concerning hydrolytic enzymes capable of cleaving ester, amide, and urethane bonds in synthetic polymers. According to the short description of the project: „The experimental part will be dedicated to: ... v) design of a set of proteins for deep polyurethane degradation, vi) design of chimeric proteins with high affinity and catalytic efficiency toward heterogeneous surface.”

In particular, the Assistant's responsibilities will include:

- protein production by overexpression in E. coli,
- protein purification using affinity chromatography and molecular filtration,
- studies of rapid enzymatic kinetics using stopped-flow or rapid freeze quench methods,
- protein crystallization,
- preparing scientific publications.

Required education:

The candidate should have a doctoral degree in chemistry, biology or related disciplines.



Skills/qualifications:

- PhD degree in chemistry, biology or related fields;
- knowledge of molecular biology methods;
- knowledge of protein purification methods;
- knowledge of methods for determining enzymatic activity;
- knowledge of methods used to determine enzymatic kinetics;
- skills in protein crystallization,
- knowledge of the English language;
- ability to conduct independent scientific work;
- the candidate must meet the requirements specified in the NCN regulations governing the principles of employment as a post-doc in the OPUS competition (28th edition)*.

*A post-doc contract is reserved for a person who obtained a doctoral degree in the year of employment in the project or within the 12 years preceding 1 January of the year of employment in the project. This period may be extended by the duration of long-term (over 90 days) documented sick leave or rehabilitation leave due to incapacity for work. Additionally, this period may be extended by the number of months spent on childcare-related leaves granted under the provisions of the Labour Code, and in the case of women – by 18 months for each child born or adopted, if this method of indicating career breaks is more beneficial.

Moreover, during the period of receiving remuneration, a person employed in a post-doc position may not receive any other remuneration from funds awarded under direct costs from research projects financed through NCN calls, nor may they receive remuneration from another employer under an employment contract, including an employer based outside the territory of Poland.

Specific requirements:

2. Completed and signed “Consent to the processing of personal data for the needs necessary to carry out the recruitment process” in accordance with the Act of 29 August 1997 on the protection of personal data (t.j. 4. Full CV (including information on maternal leaves, voluntary work and periods of work in the industry).
5. At least one opinion on the Candidate given by an independent researcher.
6. List of scientific achievements (scientific papers, patent, patent applications, grants, etc.).
7. The Candidate’s report on his/her scientific interests and research aims (an A4 page).

Eligibility criteria:

- Documented experience in conducting scientific research in the field of biochemistry, biological chemistry or related fields, confirmed by a list of publications in journals from the Journal Citation Reports list (0-10 points). Minimum number of points required: 3;
- Knowledge of protein purification techniques (0-5 points). Minimum number of points required: 2;
- Knowledge of protein crystallization techniques (0-5 points). Minimum number of points required: 2.
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Selection process:

The deadline for submitting documents is **February 20, 2026** at 3:00 pm GTM+1. The competition will be concluded by March 6, 2026. Candidates will be notified about the result.

The employment will be proceeded with accordance to the rules of Labour Code for the period 24 months.

In the case of candidates with equivalent qualifications or a need for further clarification of information provided selected candidates will be asked to participate in an on-line interview.
